

**CUTTING/CONSTRUCTION INSTRUCTIONS: Block Corners**

	THROW	TWIN	QUEEN	KING
<b>BACKGROUND:</b> Cut strips at 4½" x WOF; cut half square triangle units using the Omni 96 Ruler				
Strips to cut	6	9	11	12
Triangles needed	80	120	144	168
<b>CONTRAST:</b> Cut strips @ 2½" x WOF; crosscut @ 2½"; draw line on diagonal once				
Strips to cut	5	8	9	11
Squares needed	80	120	144	168
<b>MAIN:</b> Cut strips @ 4½" x WOF; cut half square triangle units using the Omni 96 Ruler				
Strips to cut	6	9	11	12
Triangles needed	80	120	144	168

1. Join a main fabric triangle to a background fabric triangle. Press seams to the main fabric. You need the following number of half square triangle units:

THROW: 80 TWIN: 120 QUEEN: 144 KING: 168



do this part second



2. Layer the contrast square on the background triangle right sides together as shown and sew on the drawn line. Trim away the waste triangle and press the seam to the contrast fabric. The unit should square to 4 1/2". You need the following number of corner units:

THROW: 80 TWIN: 120  
QUEEN: 144 KING: 168
