

## CUTTING/CONSTRUCTION INSTRUCTIONS: Block Center

	THROW	TWIN	QUEEN	KING
<b>BACKGROUND:</b> Cut strips at 2½" x WOF				
Strips to cut	2	2	3	3
<b>CONTRAST:</b> Cut strips @ 1½" x WOF				
Strips to cut	4	4	6	6
<b>CONTRAST:</b> Cut strips @ 4½" x WOF; crosscut @ 1½"				
Strips to cut	2	3	3	4
Rectangles needed	40	60	72	84

1. Join a contrast strip (1½" x WOF) to the top and bottom of the background strip. (2½" x WOF)

You will need the following number of strip sets:  
THROW: 2 TWIN: 2 QUEEN: 3 KING: 3

*remember to always use a 1/4" seam allowance when piecing quilt patches and blocks*

2. Crosscut the strip set at 2½". You will need the following number of patch units:

THROW: 20 TWIN: 30 QUEEN: 36 KING: 42



3. Add a patch from the contrast fabric (1½" x 4½") to each of the patch units from Step 2. You need the following number of block centers:

THROW: 20 TWIN: 30 QUEEN: 36 KING: 42
